

Course Topics

Mailroom Security - Explains the role of the mailroom facility, why it is important to screen mail, and details the procedure to follow when a threat or prohibited item is detected. It also identifies safety precautions that should be followed on the job in order to keep others safe.

Identifying a Threat - Teaches the student to recognize common traits used to identify suspicious mail or packages. The student will also learn how an Explosive Trace Detector (ETD) is useful for screening envelopes, boxes, parcels, explosive substances.
